The aspersing bowl is filled from the Well and the censer is kindled from the Fire. Ritual participants are cleansed with water from the well and purified with smoke from the censor. After the participants are cleansed and purified the Nemeton is cleansed and purified as the following power building chant is led.

When all participants have been purified Carrion will step forward saying:

The Norn officiants will begin to weave the web throughout the participants as the Bard leads the following chant.

Tonight we call out from the crossroads to our guests of honor! As we prepare to make our final sacrifice. *The final sacrifice is prepared.* 

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It is in love, honor and respect that we have offered hospitality to the Norns this night. We have sung their praise; made our sacrifice. It is our hope that our words and sacrifice have conveyed our love. We call once more through the Gates and deep within the Otherworld that all shall know of our devotion. Urd, Verdandi and Skuld, we honor you. The final sacrifice is made. Norns, accept our sacrifice! All: Norns, accept our sacrifice! Participants chant the following, sending their energies through the gates. Let us raise our voices in song to the Norns as they reveal their will. The seer then interprets the omen asking if our sacrifice and offerings have been accepted. Once all participants have had an opportunity to receive an answer to their question...

Remember that above us burns the primal fires filled with the spark of all life. It is these powers that have illuminated the waters that surge through you.(pause 8 count) The primal powers of fire and water unite within us bringing new life and balance to our beings. Our hearts beat with the very pulse of all worlds (pause 8 count)

Remember that we share these worlds with the Spirits of Nature, with the Ancestors and with the Gods. We are all cradled in the branches of the Yggdrasill.

Take of the powers that flow within you what you need and release back into the earth and sky all that has gone unused. Know that the fire and water that flows from us helps to sustains the worlds, the realms and the Kindred as we conclude our worship.

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May all that is be what was, that it may be again!
